Location: US 29 South Business to a right turn at Sweet Briar Drive at the main entrance (east) to Sweet Briar College. Follow Sweet Briar Drive to Boathouse Road. Turn left off Boathouse Road onto a gravel/dirt road that goes across the dam between 2 lakes. Take the right fork up the hill at the sign. This road leads into the burial grounds. A plaque on a large rock reads" Sacred Resting Place Of Unknown Founders Who Labored To Build What Has Become Sweet Briar College. We Are In Their Debt. There are some 60 fieldstone markers and several gravesites. The slave cemetery was probably established by the Elijah Fletcher family ca. 1830. Ancestors of the Jasper Fletcher family may be buried here.
